## Westfield House of Theological Studies, Cambridge

Live, study, and worship together for one semester with a dozen fellow students and a CUI professor at Westfield House in Cambridge, England—one of the world's oldest and most famous university towns.

In The Core Cambridge Program you will take Core English 201 and Core History 201 as well as, typically, three other general education courses in the Fine Arts (Christianity and the arts), Global Perspectives (e.g., imagining reality through the eyes of British science fiction), and either Old Testament or New Testament. At the start of the semester, you will also take a short course introducing you to English life to acquaint you with the academic and social customs of Cambridge.

The Core Cambridge courses give you greater freedom and responsibility to be a student. The courses emphasize reading and discussing texts in seminars as well as writing and presenting papers in individual or small-group tutorials. As a CUI student at Westfield House, you can attend lectures by professors at Cambridge University and use the University Library. If you are interested (and for a small fee), you can even seek to set up a supervised study on a topic of your choice with a professor from Cambridge University.

In connection with your courses, you will travel to sites such as the British Museum in London, Canterbury Cathedral, and Shakespeare's Stratford-upon-Avon. You will also have free time to travel to and trek around Europe during the mid-semester break.
